In 1932, Ray Moloney formed **Bally Manufacturing Company**. The company and their first game was named after the humor magazine **Ballyhoo**. It was the first coin operated game and they sold over 50,000 units.

Pinball History

The story of pinball starts in France in the 1700s with the game of **Bagatelle**. Originally played more like billiards with a ball being put into play with a cue stick. Soon tables got smaller and pins were added to the playfield to **randomize** the action of the ball. These pins are where pinball gets its name. In 1871, **Montague Redgrave**, an English immigrant living right here in Cincinnati invented the plunger. From this time until the 1930s games were purely **mechanical** (PM).

Tournament Recap

October 19th was the first tournament at **Pinball Garage** in Hamilton. Columbus brought the heat, with two of the top three finishers, including the winner

Carlos DeLaSerda (laser_los on Twitch).

Erik Wurtenberger (NKY) was second and **Tom Fontaine** (Columbus) was 3rd. 32 players competed including lots of new players which is great. They did a matchplay qualifying and the top six were seeded into a ladder format for finals.
